

First Ever Swanson/ Swanson Finish at AAS!

Roseville, Ca- Kody Swanson (#75) won the fifty lap feature for the USAC Sprint Cars at The All American Speedway last Saturday night, May 30th. To do it, he had to beat his brother Tanner (#17). So he did just that!

“This was the first time this has ever happened!” Kody said after the race. “Tanner raced me cleanly the whole race. For us to finish first and second just goes to show how awesome our TK Motorsports Team is! You guys are the best!”

“I used to say that if we were ever in this situation (first and second racing for a win) I would spin him so quickly!” Tanner said post-race. “Kody raced me cleanly for the win. To finish second to him... we’ll take it! What a great race! We lost a family member this weekend so this is kind of emotional. Really special!”

Point’s Leader JoJo Helberg (#7) crossed the stripe third with yet another consistent top-five effort. His lead is five over Tanner Swanson.

Brian McClish (#4b) had a very strong run finishing fourth.

Eric Humphries (#16) rounded out the top five.

In qualifying, Kody Swanson grabbed Fast Time and set a new AAS Track Record with a circuit of 12.180/88.670MPH. The time was almost three tenths of a second faster than the record set just last season by Tony Hunt at (12.464/ 86.650MPH). One has to wonder if the eleven second barrier can be far off for these rocket ships of speed.

Three other drivers qualified under the old record. JoJo Helberg was second quick at 12.285. Tanner Swanson was third at 12.426 and Brian McClish was fourth at 12.449.
