

Moore is Best; Wins Toyota TRD 100 at AAS!

Granite Bay's John Moore in his #27 AT&T Yellow Pages.com won the Toyota TRD 100 for the Late Models at The All American Speedway last Saturday night, July 18th.

Sacramento's Bobby Butler (3) started from the pole with Rookie Jake Gomes (16X) on his outside. Sacramento's Jonathan Mawhinney (17) and Orangevale's Gary Glenn started from Row 2. Moore started fifth with and inverted Jason Romero (8) of Cameron Park is sixth.

Green Flag on 100 laps! Butler is strong up front at the point and leads the first thirteen until Jake Gomes makes a smart pass for the lead on Lap 14. On Lap 15, both Glenn and Moore get by Butler and he goes off track and would not return. Romero gets by Mawhinney for fourth. Its Gomes, Glenn, and Moore after 19 laps.

Moore makes a great pass on Glenn for second and wants more! The battle begins between the young rookie and wily veteran. Romero gets by Glenn for the third spot. Mawhinney holds tough in fifth.

On Lap 30 Romero begins to struggle he's going backwards and falls to fifth. Glenn and Mawhinney move up one spot each. Pine Grove's Matt Scott (35) started eighth and is headed towards the front. He's fourth on Lap 34. Gomes is solid up front but Moore begins to measure him up.

With 40 laps remaining, Moore seizes his opportunity and makes a great pass for the lead on Gomes who falls to second. Galt's Juan Pitta (16) started ninth and is charging. With 40 to go, he rides around in fifth.

Try as he might, Gomes could not catch Moore. Moore goes on to win the 100 Lap Feature. Gomes turns in an excellent run coming home second. Glenn comes home third. Matt Scott would cross fourth. Jonathan Mawhinney rounds out the top five.

Earlier in the day, Jason Romero laid down Fast Time in qualifying with a lap of 13.924/ 77.564.

All four drivers were matched up for the division's Trophy Dash where Mawhinney defeated Glenn, Moore, and Romero respectively.

In the Late Model Point's chase, Romero continues to lead. His advantage is 44 over Moore. Pitta is third 77 back. Mawhinney is fourth 78 back. Glenn is 88 back in fifth.

Modifieds

Andy Field (8) returned to AAS after a long absence to win the 40 Lap Feature for the Modifieds.

With the invert, Lincoln's Nick Lyons (43) started P-1 with Sal Lopez on his outside. Row 2 had Field (8) starting third with 16 year old Jessica Brunelli (3) fourth. Let's Go Green!

Lyons leads Lap 1, Lopez Lap2. Lyons grabs it back on Lap 4. Good action up front. Meanwhile, Anderson (11) makes a good pass and gets by Field for third. Jarred Beddow (50) starts sixth and gets to fourth on Lap 8. Lyons is looking tough to beat up front in clean air.

Here's where this starts to get really good. Andy Field is charging to the front as we are approaching the midway point of the race. He's third on Lap 8. He gets by Lopez (02) for second on Lap 11. Lyons and Field begin to separate themselves from the rest of the pack. It's a two car race.

Lap after lap Lyons leads with Field ready to pounce with any opportunity. That opportunity came on Lap 33 when Field made a great pass to get around Lyons for the lead. The crowd went crazy! Just as Field was at his best, Lyons began to fade, Beddow got around him for second on Lap 34. Brunelli, who was sent to the back of the field after a spin, has fought her way all the way from the back and she makes the pass on Lyons for third. And that's how this one would finish.

Andy Field returns for his first race of the season and wins right out of the gate. Points Leader Jarred Beddow comes home second. Brunelli is the Hard Charger of the race finishing third and adding to her point's total. Lyons winds up fourth fro his efforts. Rio Linda's Ryan Peter (2) had another great run starting eighth and finishing fifth.

Roseville's Roy Smith (7) started from the pole in this thirty-five lap feature. He had Citrus Heights' "Dangerous" Dan Patton (69) on his outside for the drop of the Green.

"Mighty" Mike Dickson (76) started fourth and got by Galt's Bryan Tomerraason (80) for third. '08 Champ Mickey Owens started sixth and is dicing through the field. He gets to fourth by Lap 5 and third on Lap 10 as Smith continues to lead.

Lap 13, Owens by Patton for second and charging. Cavender gets by Patton for third on Lap 19. It's Smith, Owens, and Cavender all hungry for a win! This is getting good and setting up for what could be a big finish!

However, Lap 30 sees Cavender goes off track giving up the third spot to Patton with just a few remaining. Even as good as Mickey Owens is, he can't catch Smith in this one. Smith goes on to win! It's his second win in as many weeks. Mickey Owens will settle for second. Dan Patton turns in one of his best performances of the year crossing third. Bryan Tomerraason comes home fourth with a very solid run. Loomis' Christopher Lambert (50) quietly comes home fifth rounding out the top five.
