Romero Wins Again! Still Leads Points at AAS!

Roseville, Ca. - Cameron Park's Jason Romero in his Folsom Lake Asphalt #8 won the forty-seven lap Feature for the Late Models last Saturday night at The All American Speedway.

With an invert of three, Granite Bay's John Moore (#27) started from the pole with Stockton's Vito Ranuio (#27V) on the outside of Row 1. Row 2 saw Romero and last week's winner seventeen year old Matt Scott (#35).

Moore led the first five and looked strong. Romero got by him on Lap 6 but Moore got back around two laps later and the battle was on. The two cars looked equally as good early on. Romero's car began to come to him and he retook the lead on Lap 14. Moore drove his heart out but could not catch Romero on this night.

The race would end under a yellow/checker on Lap 47 for a late race incident.

Romero would lead the most laps on his way to victory. The win is his fourth this season and increases his point's lead to 45 over Moore. The second place finish gives Moore a one point edge over Galt's Juan Pitta (-46) for second.

Prior to the drop of the Green Flag, Romero was ranked fifth in the state. When the dust and smoke clears, Romero may be as high as second when the new rankings are posted.

Roseville's Shannon Mansch (#61), who won the first of the Twin 44's last week, turned in yet another great performance starting seventh and coming home third. Mansch turned in the fastest lap time in the race with a 14.133/ 76.417 in Lap 12.

Orangevale's Gary Glenn (#50) quietly came home fourth. The top five finish keeps him within 100 points of the lead and still gives him a glimmer of hope in the Championship Points.
