Mansch Wins Toyota TRD 100 at AAS!

Roseville, Ca- Shannon Mansch (#61) won the Toyota TRD 100 for the Late Models last Saturday night, July 4th at The All American Speedway.

Galt's Juan Pitta (BMR) started from the pole with an invert of six, with Zane Lovelace flanked on the outside of Row 1. Row 2 saw Gary Glenn and Matt Scott. Mansch started the race seventh.

Pitta led the first lap until Lovelace made the pass on Lap 2. Glenn took the lead on Lap 5. Romero started sixth and grabbed second early. Mansch was charging though. She was fourth by Lap 5, third by Lap 6, and took the lead for on Lap 17. Romero managed to make a pass for the lead on Lap 46, but was quickly passed on the very next lap by Mansch who was on a mission in this one.

Though there were several serious challenges from Romero, Mansch would go on to take the Checkers first having led the most laps and proving that she had the best car on the night. Romero, who may have been points racing, would settle for second and suffer very little effect on his points lead. John Moore (#27) has been quiet and consistent this season. His efforts were good enough for third. He finds himself second in the points just ahead of Pitta. Bobby Hodges (#89) had a strong car and looked as if he might contend for the win. However, a fourth place finish was the best he could manage on this night. Jonathan Mawhinney (#17) rounded out the top five with yet another good run for his team. He may be the Speedway's best driver of those without a win.
