

## Meeting Scheduled for Speedway

(Roseville, CA 10-16-09) All American Speedway officials announced this week that technical rule meetings for the Late Model, Modified, Street Stock and Bomber NASCAR Whelen All American Series divisions will be held next week at the Placer County Fair in the Garden Room.

The meetings have been scheduled for Wednesday evening October 28 and Thursday October 29. The hour long meetings will start with the Street Stocks at 6:30 PM on the 28<sup>th</sup> followed by the Modifieds at 8 PM. On Thursday the Late Models will kick off at 6:30 followed by the Bombers at 8. Participation in division rules meetings will be limited to NASCAR member **division drivers and car owners only** who have raced in at least two All American Speedway events in 2009.

The meetings will be moderated by track staff and they will collect the comments from the competitors about some suggested clarifications for the upcoming year. Major changes to the rules are not being suggested.

A committee has already met and made recommendations that will be shared with each division. The committee and staff have also committed to arranging the format for all of the division rules into a standard matrix.

One hour is being reserved for discussions regarding the global impacts of rule clarifications. Competitors who have specific questions or ideas about All American Speedway rules may call the speedway at anytime to share their ideas.
