The fun fulfilled Kids Night will consist of free face paintings, Bicycle contest giveaway, food specials including two free snow cones with a purchase of family pizza, news paper toss and driver autograph sessions.

NASCAR Whelen All American Series will make it's return to All American Speedway for its next championship point's race this Saturday July 16th. On tap will be NASCAR Late Models 100 followed by Modifieds 40, Street Stocks and Bombers 35 and WSRA. As the weather continues to stay hot with Saturday expecting temperatures in the low 90's the points chase will also continue to get heated providing lots of racing action.

The Modified division completed their 8th championship points race and question of the week last week was if Ostrowski will be able to continue his position gain this week, unfortunately michael suffered a bad finish causing him to lose two positions in the points ranks. Scott Winter's is still leading the way in points with a total of 194. However, Dan Jinkerson is closing in on Winters with a mere seven points from the top spot. Steve Cote won his first Modified race last weekend which assisted in closing the gap with Jinkerson. Cote is now 32 points behind second. Jason Bamberg gained two positions landing in the fourth spot with 33 points from third. Both Andy Field and Michael Ostrowski are tied for the fifth spot and are only two points from fourth. Meanwhile, Andy Field did not race last weekend making it two races Andy has missed this season. Cody Thompson made a three position gain and is now in the seventh spot. Bobby Runyan also made improvement in the rankings with a two position jump landing Bobby in the 9th position. Questions for this week is can Steve Cote make it double in a row?

The Street Stock division contested Twin 35's and lots of changes happened, highlights Mickey Owens takes the points lead. In the first 35 lap twins, Mickey Owens took the points lead from Richard Poppert Jr who suffered a bad finish handing the lead to Owens. Chris Lambert also suffered a bad finish. Mickey Owens leading the way with a total of 151 points making the jump from the third spot. Byron Gonzales made a 2 position jump landing him in the second position with only 17 points away from the top spot. Richard Poppert fell back to third as well as Chris Lambert in the fourth spot. Heading into the second round of the Twin 35 lap mains Mickey continues to lead by making it a double win for the weekend. With Mickey Owens on the top spot with a total of 196 points Mickey looks to repeat his finishes this

weekend. Richard Poppert Jr. came back with a solid finish to re gain some spots on the point's ladder. Poppert is now in the second spot with 30 points behind the leader. Byron Gonzales suffered a bad finish in the last main event causing Byron to drop down to the third position with a mere 4 points from second. Chris Lambert sitting in fourth has closed the gap with Gonzales for third with a mere five points. Dave Silva in the fifth position is 15 points from fourth, rounding out the top five. Street Stocks will continue battling for the points this Saturday. Be sure to keep an eye out for the top drivers in points as racing should provide excitement as the leaders battle out in points.

The Late Model division took a weekend off and will be retuning this Saturday with a 100 lap feature. The last NASCAR Late Model race was the Twin 50's and after the first twin 50 Matt Scott leads the division with 177 points. Both Jason Romero and Juan Pitta tied for 132 points in second. Romero had a bad finish which helped Pitta close the gap. Chris Scribner holding onto the fourth position has company from Dylan Hutchison in fifth is only two points from Scribner. Ron Chunn close in the mix in sixth is only two points from Hutchison. After the second twin 50's Matt Scott leads the division with 200 points and has a 52 point lead over second. Juan Pitta has captured the second position with a two point lead on Romero in third. Romero who is only 20 points ahead of Chris Scribner will be on his toes for the next race. Scribner extended his points lead over Hutchison with 12 points. Stanislov Osterlund made a three position jump from 11th to eighth. Question of the week is will Pitta begin to close the gap on Scott?

The Bomber division took a weekend off and will be returning this Saturday with a 35 lap feature. Question of the week last week was if Chris Paulson will continue his winning streak and Paulson finished third however both first and second were DQ'd in post tech which handed Paulson the victory. Chris Paulson extends the points lead now 48 points from last race 16 points. Erick Ray with a post tech DQ now has to work harder to make up for the 27 points he lost on Saturday. Ray in Second is now 16 points ahead of Matt Camp. Matt Camp who was also DQ'd in post tech lost his advantage of gaining on Ray. With both second and third suffering bad finishes, Richard Perez in fourth is closing the gap on third should show some great points battles for this weekend's race. Erick Bocksberger makes a jump from tenth to sixth looking to close the gap on Joe Rhodes in fifth.

On Saturday July 16th the grandstands gate will open at 4pm with qualifying around 4pm and racing at 6pm. Pit passes will be available for purchase to the public at 2 pm. The drivers meeting is scheduled for 5pm.

Adult tickets cost \$13 on Saturday with Seniors and Juniors 13-15 \$7 and Children 12-6 and under free. Family passes are \$35 including two adults and three junior's tickets. Parking is \$5 per vehicle. Special discounts are available for dedicated race fans with a 10 pack of parking passes for \$30. Save \$20 on parking and passes are good for ALL Fairground Events year long! More ticket information is available by calling (916) 786-2025.
