Championship battles roar into All American Speedway this Saturday, August 13th

As the last half of the 2011 season starts to dwindle, NASCAR points racing is leaving some battle scars at All American Speedway. The agenda for Saturday, August 13th, will feature the NASCAR Modifieds in their 40 lap main, Street Stocks and Bombers 35 laps and joining the series will be WSRA mini cups. With only six races left, some points battles have tightened and some have stretched out. Following a Saturday night filled with action on the track, excitement is kicking it up a notch as the racers battle for the 2011 championship titles.

In the street stock division, Mickey Owens continues to hold his points lead over the field, after suffering a flat tire in the last main, caused him to run from the back of the field. But he finished first without losing a win. Runner up, Richard Poppert Jr. also suffered a scare by losing his hood and having an impressive run from the back of the pack to finishing second, which now seats him a mere 31 points out of the lead. Sitting in third, Byron Gonzales continues to impress as he gains a position in the points rankings, working on narrowing the gap for second.

In the NASCAR Late Models, Matt Scott continues to lead the field with a 23 point advantage over second. Sitting in second, Jason Romero continues his winning streak as he tries to close the gap for first. Rookie driver Dylan Hutchison continues to show progression in his first year of stock car racing and has moved into the fourth position narrowing the gap for third with Juan Pitta.

Dan Jinkerson leads the Modified division with 18 points over second. Currently in second, Steve Cote, who captured his third win last weekend, is charging for the top spot. With five more races left for the 2011 season the battle for the top spot will only continue to get heated.

The whirlwind Bomber division gained a new winner to add to the 2011 winners book. Jill Schmidt, not running for points, caught her first ever feature win this past weekend. Chris Paulson, on a roll leading the way in points with a stretch of 64 points from second, is looking to lock in the 2011 All American Speedway Bomber Championship.
