Racing Resumes This Weekend at All American Speedway with Championship Points Race #10

NASCAR Whelen All American Series will make its return to All American Speedway for its next championship point's race this Saturday July 9th. On tap will be NASCAR Modifieds followed by Street Stocks Twin's, NCMA and WSRA. As the weather continues to stay hot with Saturday expecting temperatures in the 90's a break in the triple digit temperatures the points chase will also continue to get heated providing lots of racing excitement.

Question of the week last week was if Winters would be able to regain the top spot and as expected Scott Winters recaptured the points lead in the Modifieds division. Winters now leads five points over Dan Jinkerson in second. Steve Cote is still hanging onto his third spot however he has company from Andy field in fourth who is only two points from third. Charging driver is Michael Ostrowski who jumped four positions to be in fifth which is now a seven position jump in the last two races. Ostrowski who almost captured his first win this past weekend is well on his way to winning for his mother. Jason Bamberg is still holding onto the sixth position with company from Nick Lyons in seventh is eight points from sixth. Question of the week is will Ostrowski be able to gain more positions this weekend?

Question of the week last week was if Chris Paulson will continue his winning streak and Paulson finished third however both first and second were DQ'd in post tech which handed Paulson the victory. Chris Paulson extends the points lead now 48 points from last race 16 points. Erick Ray with a post tech DQ now has to work harder to make up for the 27 points he lost on Saturday. Ray in Second is now 16 points ahead of Matt Camp. Matt Camp who was also DQ'd in post tech lost his advantage of gaining on Ray. With both second and third suffering bad finishes, Richard Perez in fourth is closing the gap on third should show some great points battles for this weekend's race. Erick Bocksberger makes a jump from tenth to sixth looking to close the gap on Joe Rhodes in fifth.

No changes in the Street Stock division however keep an eye out for Richard Poppert Jr and Chris Lambert as they have been swapping lead roles in the point's championship. Richard Poppert Jr is leading the way in the Street Stocks standings as Chris Lambert is closing in on Poppert with a mere seven points from first. Mickey Owens is a mere nine points from second and is looking to join in on the mix for the top spot. In fourth is Byron Gonzales who is ten points from third and is on the road to earning his first victory at All American Speedway. Closely behind Gonzales is Kevin Owens who is four points from fourth.

The NASCAR Late Models contested the Twin 50's and after the first twin 50 Matt Scott leads the division with 177 points. Both Jason Romero and Juan Pitta tied for 132 points in second. Romero had a bad finish which helped Pitta close the gap. Chris Scribner holding onto the fourth position has company from Dylan Hutchison in fifth is only two points from Scribner. Ron Chunn close in the mix in sixth is only two points from Hutchison. After the second twin 50's Matt Scott leads the division with 200 points and has a 52 point lead over second. Juan Pitta has captured the second position with a two point lead on Romero in third. Romero who is only 20 points ahead of Chris Scribner will be on his toes for the next race. Scribner extended his points lead over Hutchison with 12 points. Stanislov Osterlund made a three position jump from 11th to eighth. The Late Model division will be taking a break from racing this weekend and will return for Kids night July 16th. Question of the week is will Pitta begin to close the gap on Scott?

On Saturday July 9th the grandstands gate will open at 4pm with qualifying around 4pm and racing at 6pm. Pit passes will be available for purchase to the public at 2 pm. The drivers meeting is scheduled for 5pm.

Adult tickets cost \$13 on Saturday with Seniors and Juniors 6-15 \$7 and Children six and under free. Family passes are \$35 including two adults and three junior's tickets. Parking is \$5 per vehicle. Special discounts are available for dedicated race fans with a 10 pack of parking passes for \$30.
