NASCAR Championship Week Number Three roars into The All American Speedway in Roseville this Saturday night, April 25th. As temperatures begin to rise, so does the heat in the divisional points chases.

The All American Speedway has seen some of the highest car counts of any track in the valley. Twenty-two cars took the Green Flag for both of the Twin 44 Magnums last week. The addition of some of the West Car drivers has brought excitement and even more quality racing to the 1/3 mile oval.

After two weeks and four individual races, here's how the points battle shapes up. Cameron Park's Jason Romero (#8) leads all drivers. That should come as no surprise with three wins out of four races.

Jonathan Mawhinney (#17) of Sacramento is second. Mawhinney has finished consistently in the top five each week. Now in his sophomore season, he is overdue for a win. It will come.

This season Galt's Juan Pitta (#16) is driving for BMR as part of NASCAR's Drive for Diversity Program. For Pitta, this is an opportunity to showcase what he is capable of with really good equipment under him. He is third in the points, forty-one back

In the Modified Division, Jarred Beddow (#50) sits atop the points lead. AAS Rookie of the Year Mike Newland of Colfax is second after strong finishes in both races so far this season. Can a win be far away for him?

In Street Stocks, Casey Cavender (#03) won his first race last week. To do it, he had to beat the best. He did. Cavender is tied for the points lead with last year's Street Stock Champion Mickey Owens (#08). Loomis' Christopher Lambert (#50) is just seventeen points behind on the outside looking in.

In the Bomber Division, Mike Kelly (#04) continues to lead all drivers. Fresh off a win last Saturday night, Roseville's Richard Perez (#50) is second just ten points back. There are five drivers within seventeen points of the points lead.

Gates will open at 3pm with qualifying shortly thereafter. Racing begins at 5pm. Don't miss a minute of this exciting action!
