After a two week layoff, all four of our premiere divisions return to action this Saturday night, June 6th, when Championship Week #7 rolls into the All American Speedway in Roseville, Ca. As the Point's Race heats up, so do the tempers!

Here's how the point's battles shape up:

In the Toyota TRD Late Model Division, Cameron Park's Jason Romero (#8) leads all comers. With two wins under his belt so far this season, Romero's lead is forty-seven over Galt's Juan Pitta (#16). Forty-nine points back in third is Elk Grove's Ron Chunn (#44). In his return to Stock Car racing, Chunn has been nothing less than impressive. Chunn is tied for third with Sacramento's Jonathan Mawhinney (#17). Granite Bay's John Moore (#27) rounds out the top five.

The Late Models will be competing in Twin 44 Magnum races. This will be two separate 44 lap races with eighty-eight points up for grabs.

In the Street Stock Division, Loomis's Christopher Lambert (#50) is in serious pursuit of a Championship this season. It appears early on that all roads in that direction will have to go through him. Sacramento's Kevin Owens (#21) got his first win of the season two weeks ago. That win moves him into second, just twelve points out. Orangevale's Casey Cavender (#03) sits third, sixteen points out.

In the Modified Division, Jarred Beddow (#50) is your point's leader. He has been unstoppable filling the shoes of last year's Champion Scott Winters. This chase is far from over though. Lincoln's Nick Lyons (#43) is lurking in second place just fifteen points out of the top spot. Galt's Les Friend (#5) is

third, only eighteen points back. Friend has had consistent runs so far and has shown that he will be a contender at the end of this season.

In the Bomber Division, the team of Roseville's Mike and Dana Kelly (#04) have led the points since Week One. Their lead is forty-six over Richard Perez (#50). Rocklin's Eric Bocksberger is on the outside looking in fifty-seven points behind in third.

Also on the schedule for this Saturday night will be the visiting "Legends of the Pacific" cars. These light-weight, scaled down replicas of the old Ford, Chevy, and Dodge Coupes fly around the 1/3 mile oval with their sooped-up motorcycle engines.

Gates will open at 4pm with qualifying shortly thereafter. Racing begins at 6pm. Don't miss a minute of this exciting action!
