

## **General Meeting Scheduled**

(Roseville, CA 2-16-09) Saturday February 21 has been selected by All American Speedway management as the 2009 kick off meeting for the NASCAR Whelen All American Series at the 1/3 mile oval track at the Placer County Fairgrounds. The meeting will begin at 11 AM and will be held at Luppe Hall at the Fairgrounds.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss all the improvements for the 2009 race season including new purse and contingency payouts, along with format changes, and other new incentive programs.

Newly named Director of Competition Jeff Macey will also introduce his officiating staff for the new year and detail how the program will run for 2009. Macey also will discuss his philosophy about the weekly program and convey his thoughts on technical inspections and race program implementation.

Discussions will also take place on regarding reduced car entry, admission prices, and holding costs wherever possible. Schedules for the new year will be available, along with fliers for the All American Showdown Open Show on March 19-21. Practice sessions are planned for March 7 and 14. NASCAR license applications will be available, and information about pit stalls and parking will be shared.

The meeting is open to all All American Speedway competitors, and friends. Limited seating is available and will be on a first come basis. Laupe Hall is located west of the Speedway near the C parking lot entrance. Access is also available through J gate off Corporation Yard Drive. The Fairgrounds is at 800 All American City Blvd. in Roseville.
