

## **Speedway Hires Macey**

(Roseville, CA 2-9-09) Placer County Fair CEO Brock Wimberley announced today that Jeff Macey was named as Director of Competition for All American Speedway in 2009. “We’re fortunate to get a person like Jeff who has a well rounded background in motorsports, and brings a new level of direction to All American Speedway”, said Wimberley. Macey will begin his duties immediately although the race season does not start until the first practice day on March 7<sup>th</sup>. “You’ve got to get things ready and let the competitors know what is going on to have a successful year. With this economy you’ve got to be proactive in assuring the racers that they will be treated fairly at All American Speedway”, Macey explained.

Macey will work closely with Dennis Gage, the current Director of Operations for the All American Speedway. “This is terrific that we can bring a guy like Jeff on board with his depth of knowledge and experience”, Gage said. “We had a terrific year in 2008 and adding Jeff will make the prospects even better for 2009”, he concluded.

Macey has most recently been President and General Manager of Altamont Motorsports Park in Tracy. Altamont Motorsports Park was the home of the 2008 NASCAR Whelen All-American Series California Champion. Uncertainty surrounding the opening of Altamont has prompted Macey to make the move. He has also been instrumental in forming the traveling Westcar Late Model series that canvassed most Northern California paved tracks. Macey has plans to incorporate some Westcar racing into the All American Speedway program that will boost car counts this season.

All American Speedway will continue to be a NASCAR Whelen All-American Series home track featuring Late Models, Modifieds, Street Stocks, and Bombers on a weekly basis beginning on March 28<sup>th</sup>. The season will get underway with practice days on March 7<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> followed by a brand new All American Speedway Showdown open show on March 19<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup>. The 19<sup>th</sup> will be an open practice session for all divisions followed by two days of racing for the four NASCAR divisions plus the new track Interceptor division.

All American also will have live Speed TV on two occasions when the regional NASCAR Camping World Series comes to the 1/3 mile paved oval on April 4<sup>th</sup> and September 26<sup>th</sup>. Both events will be presented by Bill McAnally Racing of Antelope.
